Please tape your submission using the instructions included here. Once you finish recording, follow the "taping tips" for Windows or Mac to digitize the video. When you are ready to submit your video, log in to ActorCast or if you are new to AC, go to www.twihardevent.com, select your gender and click "submit" and after you fill out your information you can upload your video and submit for the role.

To make your video submission, please follow these steps:

1. When taping yourself, frame the picture just above your head to the bottom of the chest so we can see the face clearly.
2. NEXT you will 'SLATE'. Please write your name, email and phone number boldly on a piece of paper and hold it in front of you. Make sure the letters are big enough for us to see the spelling of your name and your contact information. First, shoot a few seconds of video wide enough so we can see you head to toe. Next, zoom in to the aforementioned framing and tell us your name and age. Please say these clearly, looking into the camera.
3. NEXT, TAPE YOURSELF DOING **ALL** OF THE FOLLOWING THINGS LISTED BELOW. (KEEP YOUR VIDEO UNDER **THREE** MINUTES)
 - Tell us, or better yet, convince us that you are either the biggest Edward fan or the biggest Jacob fan out there. Tell us exactly why you are on Team Edward or Team Jacob. It can be because you think Edward is Bella's true love. Or because you personally just like Jacob more. Or because you know obscure stuff that only the biggest fan could know – and that's why you like one of them better than the other. The only thing it has to be is honest – your honest feelings.

- Tell us how you would convince someone else to join your Team. What would you tell them?

4. Once finished, you will need to digitize and compress your video clip following the guidelines included on the LOL open call web site.

Helpful tips for a good audition:

- Find a quiet room that has very little or no background noise. TV's, fans, running water and air conditioning can be distracting.
- The wall behind you in should ideally be white or blue. Try to position yourself a few feet away from the wall to avoid shadows.
- Make sure you are lit well, since you want the viewer to be able to see your face clearly. (Don't film in front of a window -- this will create a silhouette, not good for shooting.)
- Your camera should ideally sit on a tripod to maintain a steady image. If you don't have a tripod, make sure you can put the camera on a stable surface or have someone hold it steadily.
- Record a test sample and see how it looks and sounds on the computer first to make final adjustments before taping the scenes. If you can't see or hear yourself well, we won't be able to either.
